Act I: The Market. In the city of Naples, the fisherman Gennaro is in love with Teresina. Teresina's mother wishes her to marry either Peppo, a lemonade salesman, or Giacomo, a macaroni salesman, but Teresina refuses them both. Seeing Teresina and Gennaro's love for one another, her mother gives her blessing for their marriage.

Gennaro and Teresina set sail to start their life together, but a terrible storm strikes. Gennaro makes it to shore, but Teresina is nowhere to be found. Heartbroken, Gennaro does not know if he can go on without her. The local monk Fra Ambrosio counsels him and gives him a medal of the Madonna. Gennaro resolves to search for Teresina.

Act II: The Blue Grotto. Teresina wakes up in the Blue Grotto, where a group of naiads have found her. Their leader, the sea demon Golfo, transforms Teresina into a naiad. When Gennaro arrives in the grotto, Golfo's enchantment means Teresina does not recognize him. Gennaro musters his love and devotion to remind her, and Teresina returns to her mortal self. This angers Golfo, but the couple's faith causes him to relent. The naiads bring Teresina and Gennaro treasures before sending them on their way.

Act III: The Wedding. Back home, everyone is so startled to see Teresina again that they believe it is the work of the devil. Gennaro and Teresina convince them that she has truly returned, and the city celebrates their union with a pas de six and an energetic tarantella.
